³⁰Now Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fever,

and they told him about her at once.

³¹He came and took her by the hand and lifted her up.

Then the fever left her,

and she began to serve them.

PATTERN OF HEALINGS

1. Arrival of Jesus

2. Description of illness

3. Implicit or explicit request for healing

4. The word or gesture of healing

5. The effecting of the deed

6. Acclamation of the crowd or external demonstration of the healing

MARK 5:21-43
HEALING OF JARIUS' DAUGHTER

²¹When Jesus had crossed again in the boat to the other side, a great crowd gathered around him; and he was by the sea.

²²Then one of the leaders of the synagogue named Jairus came and, when he saw him, fell at his feet ²³and begged him repeatedly, "My little daughter is at the point of death.

Come and lay your hands on her, so that she may be made well, and live."
²⁴So he went with him...

Then he... went in where the child was. ⁴¹He took her by the hand and said to her, "Talitha cum," which means, "Little girl, get up!"

⁴²And immediately the girl got up and began to walk about (she was twelve years of age).

At this they were overcome with amazement. ⁴³He strictly ordered them that no one should know this, and told them to give her something to eat.
